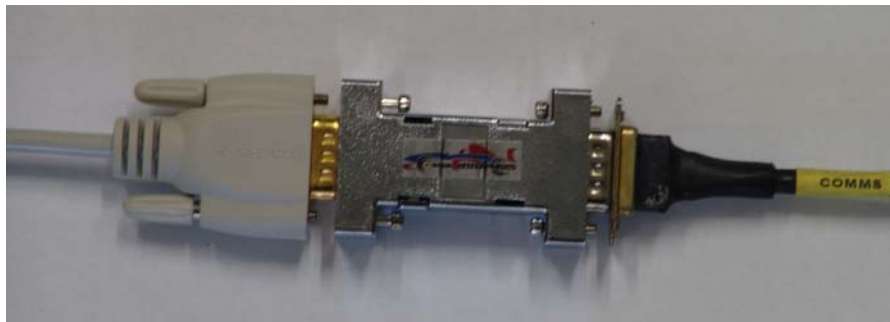
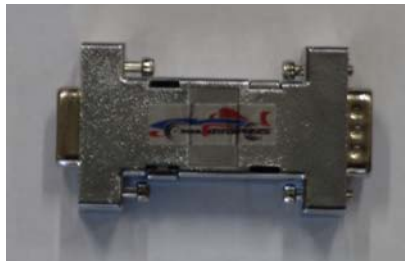
Re: Connection to the ECU

---

It was brought to my attention that plugging into the ECU with a standard (serial to serial) or a (usb to serial) cable may cause damage to the ECU. MBE only uses three of the pins for programming and diagnostic purposes. I have made an adapter that you put in between the ECU and your serial cable.

You must use the adapter if you are plugging into the ECU for any reason, so you do not cause any damage to the ECU.

This is what the adapter looks like and where it is placed:



The adapter can be purchased from SCCA Enterprises.
